# Legislative Session



- The legislative session begins in January and ends in June
- New condensed session for 2020 – due to combined Federal/State Primary
- The Governor forecasts his budget and legislative priorities in the State of the State/Executive Budget address in January
  - Traditionally these were separate addresses
  - This practice has changed year to year under Governor Cuomo

# Budget Process



- Legislative budget hearings begin after the Executive Budget proposal is released
- Both the Senate and the Assembly lay out their budget proposals in their one house budget bills and/or resolutions by early to mid March
- Legislative Conference Committees then convene
- Final budget must be passed and signed into law by April 1<sup>st</sup>

The New York State legislative session calendar establishes a schedule for the 2020 legislative session and provides dates important to the legislative process. The session calendar is intended to afford Members flexibility in conducting legislative business in Albany and planning activities within their home districts. The session calendar will foster orderly and timely consideration of legislation. Unforeseen events may require modification of the session calendar.
